

## Registration and Eligibility

All GED candidates must register in person by the Friday prior to the GED testing date. Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

In order to register for the GED test, you must be at least 18 years old and bring the following:

- **Acceptable forms of ID may include: All valid driver's licenses, passports, military ID's or other forms of government-issued ID's (national or foreign) that show name, address, date of birth, signature, and photograph.**
- **\$70 GED Test Fee - No Refunds**
- **\$14 GED Retest Fee per Subsection - No Refunds**

Students are encouraged to allow one hour for the registration process. Special accommodations for testing can be requested for students with disabilities who have the required documentation.

Accepted forms of payment are: Cash, Check, Money Order or Debit/Credit Card.

## Available Help

GED test preparation help is available if you are planning to take the GED exam. Consider attending one of the Adult Ed programs held at most Daytona State College campuses. The classes are offered year-round during the morning and evening. Also, ask about our online GED prep-classes.

- **Keep your scheduled appointment.**
- **Be on time and bring your Test Entry Pass.**
- **Bring your valid picture ID – no exceptions.**
- **No one will be allowed to leave the room once testing begins.**
- **Cell phones, calculators and other electronic devices are NOT ALLOWED.**
- **Candidates who do not show up will NOT be refunded.**

### NEW GED® TEST FOR 2014

GED® Testing Service is releasing a new version of the GED® Test on January 1, 2014. Individuals who have tested on the current 2002 GED® Test Series must complete the exam series by December 31, 2013. Scores from the 2002 Series **WILL NOT** be combined with scores for the new assessment. Candidates who do not complete the current series will have to meet the requirements of the new test, starting January 1, 2014.

**Diploma based on the requirements for the current test series:** minimum score of 410 on five sub-tests (Reading, Writing, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science) with an average score of 450. All subtest passing scores combined must add up to a **TOTAL SCORE** of 2250.

The GED is a test that measures the major outcomes and concepts generally associated with four years of high school education. Upon successful completion of this test you will receive the State of Florida High School Diploma.

The GED test consists of five test areas; Language Arts-Writing, Social Studies, Science, Language Arts-Reading and Mathematics.

The test takes approximately eight hours to complete and is taken in two morning sessions or two afternoon sessions. The GED test is offered at five Daytona State College campuses. Registration prior to the test is required.
