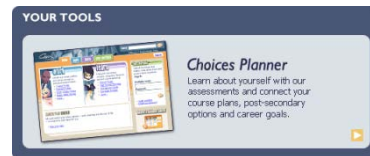
CREATE A PORTFOLIO

To review careers in specific areas of interest

- Click on the "Home" tab, and click "Career Finder".
- You can then search by areas of interest, and save the results to your portfolio.

When viewing a career

- WHAT THEY DO** Explains the tasks and functions of the career
- WHAT TO LEARN** Explains the level of education/training required, what majors you would need to study, as well as schools who offer those programs, providing a direct link to the school's website
- MONEY & OUTLOOK** Shows the entry level, average & experienced wages earned in the state of your choice as well as the projected job outlook
- CONNECTIONS** Provides links to additional websites with related career, salary & outlook information
